Our logo must be presented with both wordmark and Avatar used together as shown here. It can be used on a light or white background or with the wording reversed out in white on a dark background.

## **Rules**

To preserve brand recognition and credibility we ask that the follow rules for using the logo are adhered to.

#### **Minimum Width**

For legibility, make sure the logo is no smaller than 20mm wide. (100px for digital representation)

#### **Exclusion Zone**

A sufficient gap known as an 'Exclusion Zone' should be given so as not to compromise the logo mark. The minimum exclusion size has been defined by the height of the Avatar icon. This can be measured from the extremities of the logo.



#### Integrity

Always resize the logo proportionally (this can be done by holding down 'shift' in most software applications). Do not create your own logo mark by using an alternative typeface (always used the logo files supplied). Do not present the logo on a background colour that reduces legibility.



## Colour

We distinguish ourselves by the use of two core colours, Forest Green and Avatar Green.
